

Now that the Governor has vetoed the budget, it is back in the General Assembly's hands. They said that there are enough votes to override the veto. If this happens, the bill will become law.

The House and Senate leadership are still aiming for this Friday, June 17th to be the end of this legislative session. There are, however, plans being made for "special sessions" later in the summer/fall on redistricting and constitutional amendments.
